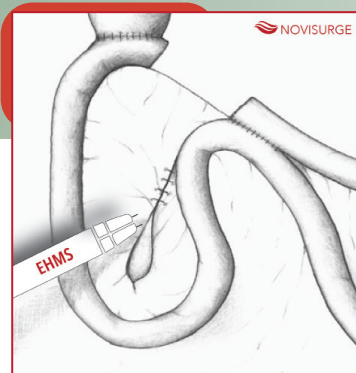
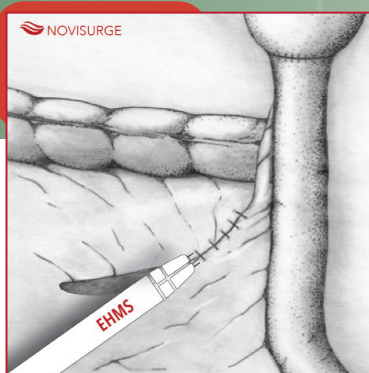


# Close with Confidence!

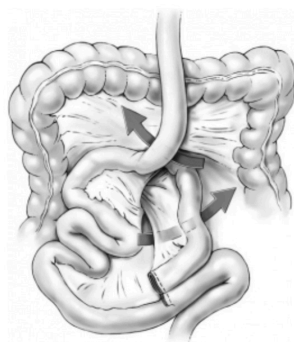
## Closure of Mesenteric Defects in Laparoscopic Roux-en-Y Gastric Bypass in order to Prevent Internal Hernias



Small bowel obstruction due to internal hernia is the most common and potentially serious complication after laparoscopic Roux-en-Y gastric bypass.

Complete closure of mesenteric defects in laparoscopic Roux-en-Y gastric bypass results in a significant reduction in internal mesenteric hernias.

The reported risk of complication caused by closure of the mesenteric defects is low. Primary closure of mesenteric defects can be performed safely and should be viewed as a routine part of that operation.



Symptoms of internal hernia:

Vague colic pain

Mostly pain in left abdomen

Intermittant character

Incidence of internal hernia:

Non-closure: 11,7%

Closure: 2,5%
